Itinerary topics, field studies and site visits

- **Māori immersion** program staying overnight at a marae including the traditional welcome (Powhiri) and stories of the Indigenous people's history and transition to society today.
- **Environmental, conservation, global green and sustainable solutions** that build resilience in a changing world. Visits to conservation sites.
- Visit **universities, research centres and innovation hubs**.
- Meet **emerging young leaders in business, politics and positions of influence**.
- Attend a special workshop about **New Zealand's response to COVID-19**.
- Field studies in key primary industries of **innovation and new technologies to discuss sustainable futures** (agriculture, horticulture, fisheries or viticulture).
- Site visits to the house of **government and observe parliament in session, learn about the political system**.
- **Tourism and adventure** activities included with visits to Hobbiton or WETA Workshop film locations, national museums and galleries, adventure activities (ziplining or rafting, kayaking or paddle boarding).

Group size

Each group will be approximately 15-20 in numbers. Minimum numbers apply.

Dates

This is a 14-day program with 12 days in-country. Subject to flights, ease of entry and reaching minimum numbers the tours are in the northern hemisphere spring and/or summer breaks (April and June).

Registration

Applicants must apply for registration and provide one verified character reference to join a tour. These programs are designed for students attending university or college, age 18 to 25.

Note: A similar tour is also available for high school students.

Travel

Each participant arranges their own return international airfares with travel insurance and visa administration to arrive in New Zealand in time for the start date. Airport meet and greet and transfers are arranged by IGENZ.
